CAMPGAW MT. ARCHERY RANGE MAINTENANCE RESUMES

As any members know, the county and the Bergen Bowmen, Inc. in a joint effort got the much needed maintenance done on the range in preparation of our Happy Halloween Fun Shoot that was scheduled for October 29, 2017.

On the practice range, all of the target structures received new bales and the 25 yrd. target structure had to get rebuilt as it was in bad shape. The 25 yrd, target was placed back into its proper placement. The practice range as well as the entrance to the range and field course got nice new safety signs.

On the 28 field target course, the course was completely remarked with red/orange florescent paint and the unapproved changes were corrected returning the course back to the last approved changes from when the club had to move 2 targets due to the Rio Vista homes. The entire course got new large reflective target number markers, you can't miss them and all of the downed trees were removed. Target #18 was moved as it was not feasible to cut the tree that was blocking it, it is in an easier location and all the vegetation around the new target location has been cut back, you can miss it now. The course got blown by us and by the county also. Targets #1, #2, #26, #27 & #28 all got new excelsior bales as well.

On the first day work began the county had a group of students from the SpringBoard Program in the Wood Ridge Transition Center of Bergen County Special Services come to the range to help. They were

a great help.

In addition, the county took down several trees that posed potential threat of coming down at any moment. Both the county and several members put in many hours getting the range ready for the October 29 Halloween shoot.
